TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- 01 **The fully intact medieval and baroque Old Town** is the main attraction itself, an UNESCO world heritage site in its entirety
- 02 **The Old Town Hall:** Unique landmark, built in the middle of the river
- 03 **Cathedral Square:** Experience all the architectural styles of the past 1000 years from one vantage point.
- 04 **World Heritage Visitor Center:** Located in the heart of the city, displays the outstanding universal value
- 05 **Trail of Modern Sculptures:** Large Sculptures by significant contemporary artists are located throughout the city

- ★ **Jun. – Sep.:** Music festivals

- ★ **Dec.:** **Christmas Market and Nativity Scenes** with a huge variety of Christmas Cribbs



CITY'S HISTORY

- ★ **1007:** Founded by Emperor Henry II and capital of the Holy Roman Empire
- ★ Many medieval foundations of churches, monasteries and palaces
- ★ **1489:** The Bamberg Purity Law for beer is introduced – 27 years before the famous Bavarian Purity Law
- ★ **1946:** The Bamberg Symphony Orchestra is established
- ★ **1993:** Appointed as UNESCO World Heritage Site

- ★ ... Bamberg is home of the most infamous beer of all? Smoked beer is brewed with malt roasted over open fires, capturing centuries-old smoky flavors. Taste it straight from the wooden barrel in Bamberg's brew taverns!



TOP DAY EXCURSIONS

- 01 **Levi Strauss Museum in Buttenheim:** Birth place of Levi Strauss, the inventor of blue jeans
- 02 **Tree top canopy pathway:** In the middle of Steigerwald forest
- 03 **Franconian Switzerland:** Mountainous area with stalactite caves, rock formations and castles
- 04 **Seehof Palace:** Baroque palace with gardens and water cascades
- 05 **Schloss Weissenstein Palace:** A prestigious example of Franconian Baroque architecture with portrait galleries and a fully furnished interior
