- 03 **Käthe Wohlfahrt** – all-year Christmas Village, German Christmas Museum and top-quality christmas decorations shop
- 04 **St. James' Church** – with the Holy Blood Altar by woodcarver Tilman Riemenschneider
- 05 **Rothenburg Museum** – with monastery kitchen from the 13th century

- ★ **960:** First community Detwang
- ★ **1142:** Erection of the Imperial Castle (destroyed in 1356)
- ★ **1274:** Free Imperial City
- ★ **1802:** Rothenburg is annexed to the Bavarian Kingdom



DID YOU KNOW THAT ...

- ★ in 1986 Argentine Jesuit and priest Jorge Mario Bergoglio lived in Rothenburg o. d. Tauber for a few months to learn German? In March 2013, he was elected Pope and became known as Pope Franciscus I.

- 02 **Landwehr-Bräu Brewery** in Reichelshofen (5 mi. east of Rothenburg)
- 03 **Spa therapies at "Franken-Therme"** Bad Windsheim (17 mi. east of Rothenburg)
- 04 **Golfing** at the Rothenburg-Schönbronn Golf Course (7 mi. south of Rothenburg)
- 05 **Sweeping formal gardens** and orangery of the royal palace in Ansbach (21 mi. east of Rothenburg)
