REGION'S HISTORY

More than 10.000 years ago:

Lake Constance was formed during the last ice age in the alpine region

- Lovingly called **Bodensee** by locals, the Lake is not named after the biggest City Constance in German but one of the oldest settlements,
- ★ 1963: Last 'Seegefrörne' Lake Constance froze over



DID YOU KNOW THAT ...

- ... Lake Constance is Europe's biggest reservoir: it supplies up to 4 million households with drinking water every day.
- ... the lake is borderless? All three surrounding states have sovereign rights on the lake.

- **Germany:** Mainau Island the famous flower island; Friedrichshafen with Zeppelin Museum and hangar
- **Austria:** Bregenz Festival on world's largest floating stage;
 Bregenz hiking or cable car trip to mountain Pfänder (1.064m).
- O3 Switzerland: Säntis mountain (2.502m); Appenzeller show dairy; Town of St. Gall baroque abbey & library (UNESCO site),
- O4 Principality of Liechtenstein:

 hiking; Vaduz Treasure Chamber,
 Princely winery
