TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- 01 Stone Bridge** – the oldest preserved bridge of its kind in Germany
- 02 St. Peter's Cathedral** – the only example of French Gothic architecture in Bavaria
- 03 Thurn and Taxis Palace** – in the middle of the 18th century the princess of Thurn and Taxis, founders of the first large-scale postal service in Europe (15th century), created a magnificent castle here
- 04 Old Town Hall** – Imperial Assembly Museum
- 05 Museum of Bavarian History** – permanent exhibition tracing Bavaria's path to becoming a Free State and what makes it so distinctive



SEASONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- ★ **May: Days of Old Music**
- ★ **May & Aug./Sep.: Dult.** Regensburg's mini-version of the Oktoberfest (twice a year)
- ★ **Jun/Jul.: Bavarian Jazz Weekend** in the Old Town
- ★ **July: Open Air Music Festival** in the courtyard of the Thurn & Taxis Palace
- ★ **Dec.: Five Christmas markets** all over town including the world-famous Romantic Christmas market at the Thurn and Taxis Palace



CITY'S HISTORY

- ★ Founded by the Romans 179 AD
- ★ Known as Germany's best preserved medieval city
- ★ UNESCO World Heritage since 2006
- ★ Nowadays, an economic booming and university city with a young life-style in old city walls



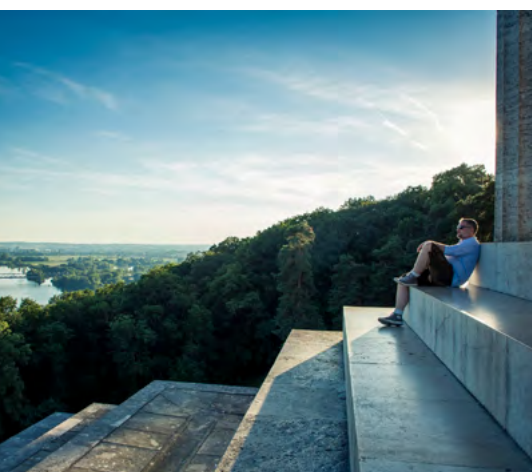
DID YOU KNOW THAT ...

- ★ Regensburg is home of the oldest sausage kitchen in the world, the Wurstkuchl (Historic Sausage Kitchen) and also the oldest coffeehouse in Germany, the Café Prinzess?



TOP DAY EXCURSIONS

- 01 Walhalla** – temple built by King Ludwig I to honor German heroes through the ages; it is a copy of the Pantheon in Athens
- 02 Boat trip from Kelheim** – through the Danube Gorge to Weltenburg Abbey, the oldest monastery brewery in the world
- 03 Bavarian Forest** – with crystal factories, National park and many museums
- 04 "Liberation Hall"** – built by King Ludwig I in memory of the wars of Liberation fought by the Germany states against Napoleon
- 05 Crystal Museum Riedenburg** – with the largest cluster of rock crystal found in America and the biggest emerald crystal
