



TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- **800-year-old castle** with Knight's Halls and ceremonial rooms; it has 22 rooms and suites in an individual castle style
- **"Sophienhöhle"**, one of Germany's loveliest dripstone caves with impressive stalactite formations and one of the most complete cave bear skeletons in the world
- **Falconry** with large bird park for birds of prey and owls plus a fascinating flying display
- Tavern and beer garden with regional Franconian cuisine and beer specialties
- **Walking and climbing** the 5 km Promenade Trail, used by King Ludwig I of Bavaria back in 1830, starts right outside the castle doors





SEASONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- ★ June to Aug.: Medieval market with exhibition fights, jugglers, traders and craftsmen, puppet theater, medieval music and fire shows
- Spring/Summer: Cave concerts from world music to blues and Klezmer
- May to Dec.: Wild boar buffet featuring a whole wild boar on a spit
- Oct. to Dec.: Fiery evenings with fiery food and a fire show in the castle forecourt
- ongoing: Castle concerts from classical music to jazz
- ★ Ongoing: Dinner shows such as magic, murder mystery and horror dinner

- 1188: First documented mention of Burg Rabenstein
- ★ **1830:** Visit of King Ludwig I of Bavaria
