TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- 01 Lake Chiemsee:** The largest lake in Bavaria, known as the Bavarian Sea, with its two famous islands, Herreninsel and Fraueninsel
- 02 Herrenchiemsee New Palace:** known as the Bavarian Versailles and located on Herreninsel
- 03 Exhibition Center Lokschuppen:** Houses changing special exhibitions, one of the most successful exhibition-centers of Bavaria, located in the city center of Rosenheim
- 04 Wasserburg:** Historic old town with its colorful gothic houses and archways
- 05 Neubeuern:** Beautiful historic village with world famous wall paintings called Lüftlmalerei
- 06 Hohenaschau Castle:** Medieval castle in Aschau i. Chiemgau housing the Priental Museum



SEASONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- ★ **May to Sept:** Classical Festivals (e.g. in castles)
- ★ **May to Oct.:** Bavarian Folklore Festivals
- ★ **Aug./Sep.:** Rosenheim Beer Festival
- ★ **Oct:** Bavaria's biggest apple market in Bad Feilnbach
- ★ **Dec.:** Traditional Christmas Markets throughout the region



REGION'S HISTORY

- ★ **10,000 years ago:** Lake Chiemsee was formed at the end of the Ice Age when glacier movements created alpine uplands dotted with lakes
- ★ **1878:** Herrenchiemsee New Palace was built by fairytale King Ludwig II
- ★ **1945:** End of WWII, the AFRC was set in Bernau am Chiemsee and Bad Aibling Station in Bad Aibling.

- ★ the world's only replica of Versailles can be found on the island of Herrenchiemsee?
- ★ the region offers more than 50 mountain summits and 60 Alpine pastures?

- 02 Wendelstein Cog Railway:** Experience Germany's oldest high mountain railway
- 03 Hocheck Adventure Mountain:** Family experience for everyone, includes freefall slide, mountain railway, summer tobogganing and much more
- 04 Wellness Retreat:** Thermal baths in Bad Aibling and Bad Endorf
