



TOP SIGHTSEEING **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Lake Chiemsee: The largest lake in Bavaria, know as the Bavarian Sea, with its two famous islands. Herreninsel and Fraueninsel
- Herrenchiemsee New Palace: 02 known as the Bavarian Versailles and located on Herreninsel
- Exhibition Center Lokschup-03 pen: Houses changing special exhibitions, one of the most successful exhibition-centers of Bavaria, located in the city center of Rosenheim
- Wasserburg: Historic old town 04 with its colorful gothic houses and archways
- **Neubeuern:** Beautiful historic 05 village with world famous wall paintings called Lüftlmalerei
- Hohenaschau Castle: Medieval 06 castle in Aschau i. Chiemgau housing the Priental Museum





SEASONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- May to Sept: Classical Festivals (e.g. in castles)
- May to Oct.: Bayarian Folklore **Festivals**
- Aug./Sep.: Rosenheim Beer **Festival**
- Oct: Bavaria's biggest apple market in Bad Feilnbach
- Dec.: Traditional Christmas Markets throughout the region



REGION'S HISTORY

- 10,000 years ago: Lake Chiemsee was formed at the end of the Ice Age when glacier movements created alpine uplands dotted with lakes
- **1878:** Herrenchiemsee New Palace was built by fairytale King Ludwig II
- 1945: End of WWII, the AFRC was set in Bernau am Chiemsee and Bad Aibling Station in Bad Aibling.
