CITY'S HISTORY

- 1056: Coburg is mentioned for the first time
- 1542: Coburg first becomes a royal seat
- 1530: Reformer Martin Luther resides at Veste Coburg and preaches at the Church of St. Maurice
- 1840: Prince Albert marries his cousin, Queen Victoria of Great Britain and Ireland
- 1920: The Free State of Coburg decides to join the Free State of Bavaria
