- 01 **Partnach Gorge** – natural landmark with wild waterfalls, rapids, and tranquil water basins
- 02 **Olympic Stadium with ski jump** – setting of the 1936 winter Olympic games
- 03 **Zugspitze** – Germany's highest mountain rising 2,962 m and known as "Top of Germany"
- 04 **AlpspiX** – impressive scenic-view platform with glass wall
- 05 **Wamberg** – highest church village in Germany

- 01 **Neuschwanstein Castle** – world famous for its fairytale design and inspiration to Disney's Sleeping Beauty castle
- 02 **Linderhof Castle** – only palace King Ludwig II was able to complete
- 03 **Oberammergau Passion Play Theatre** – where the Passion Play takes place every 10 years
- 04 **Ettal Monastery** – founded in 1330 by Duke of Bavaria and Roman Emperor of German Nations, King Louis IV
- 05 **Mittenwald** – rural mountain village at the border of Austria
