TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- 01 The fully intact medieval and baroque Old Town is the main attraction itself, an UNESCO world heritage site in its entity
- 02 The Old Town Hall: Unique landmark, built in the middle of the river
- 03 Cathedral Square: Experience all the architectural styles of the past 1000 years from one vantage point.
- 04 World Heritage Visitor Center: Located in the heart of the city, displays the outstanding universal value
- 05 Trail of Modern Sculptures: Large Sculptures by significant contemporary artists are located throughout the city

CITY'S HISTORY

- 1007: Founded by Emperor Henry II and capital of the Holy Roman Empire
- ★ Many medieval foundations of churches, monasteries and palaces
- 1489: The Bamberg Purity Law for beer is introduced – 27 years before the famous Bavarian Purity Law
- 1946: The Bamberg Symphony Orchestra is established
- 1993: Appointed as UNESCO World Heritage Site
