TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- 01 Residence Palace and Court Garden** (UNESCO world heritage) – one of the most impressive Baroque castles in Europe, adorned by the largest ceiling fresco in the world
- 02 Marienberg Fortress** – visible from afar and dating back to the 13th century, the imposing fortress is Würzburg's landmark
- 03 Cathedral of St Kilian** – 4th largest Romanesque cathedral in Germany with a striking, bright interior design
- 04 Old Main Bridge** – popular meeting point for locals and guests for a glass of wine
- 05 Historic Wine Cellars** – a visit of one to the centuries-old wine cellars in the city center is a must

CITY'S HISTORY

- ★ **704:** First official mentioning of Würzburg
- ★ **1582:** Founding of the university
- ★ **1720:** Construction begins for the Residence Palace
- ★ **1814:** Würzburg is annexed by Bavaria
- ★ **1895:** Wilhelm Conrad Röntgen discovered X-rays
- ★ **1981:** UNESCO declared the Residence Palace and Court Garden world heritage

TOP DAY EXCURSIONS

- 01 Rothenburg ob der Tauber** – just 1 hour away, Rothenburg is a mandatory stop on the Romantic Road, Germany's most popular tourist route
- 02 Tour of the picturesque wine villages of the Franconian Wine Country** – surrounded by vineyards and with medieval centers, the nearby villages of Randersacker, Sommerhausen and Iphofen are easily accessible
- 03 River Cruise to Veitshöchheim castle and Rococo Garden** – the perfect excursion from Apr. to Oct.
- 04 Daytrip to the medieval town of Bamberg** – UNESCO world heritage
- 05 Cycle along the "Main-Radweg"** – a popular cycling trail
