



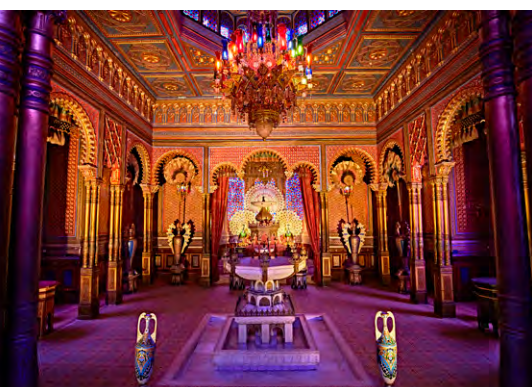
Linderhof Palace

BACKDROP FOR A KING'S DREAM



TOP HIGHLIGHTS

- 01 Linderhof Palace:** one of the most diverse and most artistic complexes of the 19th century. Linderhof is the only palace where King Ludwig II lived for a significant time. Further, it was the only one out of the three royal palaces to be completed.
- 02 Linderhof Park:** The park combines magnificent Baroque water parterres and cascades with themes from the English landscape garden.
- 03 Moroccan House and Moorish Kiosk:** Both are lavish examples of the oriental trends that was cultivated by King Ludwig II.
- 04 Tours:** Regular tours are available in English. Duration is 25 minutes and maximum of 40 persons. Escorted audio guide tours are available in several languages. Additional tours in English for groups can be arranged with advanced notice.

- ★ **August: King Ludwig's Night,** the celebration of Ludwig's birthday



DID YOU KNOW THAT ...

- ★ before Linderhof Palace was built, another building had been standing where the palace is located now? The so called "Royal Lodge", which dates from 1790, was moved at the king's request in 1874. It had already been used by Maximilian II, Ludwig's father, as a hunting lodge. Ludwig II lived in it frequently before the palace was completed. Today's exhibition in the Royal Lodge covers topics such as the building's origins as a farm, its use by the royal family and its significance as a planning office for Ludwig II's many building projects.
