



TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- Palaces of Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau plus the "Museum of the Bavarian Kings" (2,5 miles)
- **Historic center of Füssen** with its Baroque churches, Gothic houses and medieval town walls
- Museum of the City of Füssen in the former St. Mang Abbey and the Castle courtyard of "Hohes Schloss" (High Castle)
- **Boat trip on Lake Forggensee** (season: June to mid. October), panoramic view of Neuschwanstein Castle and Füssen
- O5 Cable car trip to the summit of Mount Tegelberg (360 panoramic view)





SEASONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- ★ Jan 3 Oct. 5: Ludwig the musical at the "Festspielhaus Neuschwanstein", located on the shores of Lake Forggensee
- ★ July 31 Aug.3: Neuschwanstein Concerts – Open-air classical music in the upper courtyard of Neuschwanstein Castle
- Aug. 1-3: Medieval market in "Freyberg Park" near the old town
- ★ Aug. 8 9: Streetfestival live music and steet performers in all old town squares from Bavaria to salsa. Free admission
- ★ Dec. 6 8 and Dec. 13 15: Adventsmarkt (Christmas Market) in the courtyard of the former St. Mang monastery



TOP DAY EXCURSIONS

- **Palace of Linderhof** (27 miles via Reutte/Tyrol and Plansee)
- **Zugspitze** highest mountain peak in Germany (24 miles)
- O3 Sights and towns along the Romantic Road, e.g. the "Wieskirche" pilgrimage church (16 miles)
- Augsburg holds UNESCO world heritage site title for its impressive water management system (80 miles)
- **Munich** capital city of Bavaria (82 miles)
