



TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- **Veste Coburg** 'Franconian Crown', one of the best-preserved medieval fortresses in Germany, with outstanding art collections
- O2 Ehrenburg Palace accords a glimpse into the grandiose living and sleeping quarters of Coburg's nobility, with an impressive neo-Gothic façade
- Callenberg Palace tells the family history of the dukes of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha
- Museum of Natural History –
 the largest of its kind in Northern
 Bavaria, dedicated to the geological
 history of Upper Franconia
- Market Square urban center of the city, surrounded by historical monuments, stores and cafés

CITY'S HISTORY

- ★ 1056: Coburg is mentioned for the first time
- ★ 1530: Reformer Martin Luther resides at Veste Coburg and preaches at the Church of St. Maurice
- ★ 1542: Coburg first becomes a royal seat
- ★ 1840: Prince Albert marries his cousin, Queen Victoria of Great Britain and Ireland
- ★ 1920: The Free State of Coburg decides to join the Free State of Bayaria

- **Rosenau Palace** birthplace of Prince Albert of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha
- **Hofgarten Park** landscaped as an English-style country park in 1858, ascend to Veste Coburg
- **Globe Coburg** the round form of Coburg's new theater is based on the London Globe, perfect acoustic, accommodating up to 500 theatergoers
- Culinary guided tour discover the city and sample a range of traditional tidbits
- O5 Carl Escher Trail hiking trail and cycle way, perfect to discover and experience Coburg and its surroundings
