



OVERVIEW

Neuschwanstein Castle is one of the best-known buildings in the world and is built on a rugged hill against a backdrop of picturesque mountain scenery. The church-like Throne Hall was modeled on Byzantine domed architecture.



PALACE'S HISTORY

- **1868:** Building began but it was never completed
- ★ Up to 8 meters of stone outcrop were removed to make way for the foundations
- Neuschwanstein is a Historicist creation of a medieval castle
- → Decorated with series of pictures depicting Old Norse and chivalric legends and the heraldic animal of the counts of Schwangau
- **1886:** Officially opened to the public
